UPMC MyHealth 24/7 Nurse Line	Phone service in which a UPMC registered nurse answers questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Advice for treating a condition at home Guidance about whether to seek a higher level of care 	24 hours a day, seven days a week	No cost
UPMC AnywhereCare <i>(download the App in the Apple Store or Google Play)</i>	Virtual urgent care visit with a provider right from your computer, tablet, or smartphone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Colds, sinus infections, and allergy symptoms Bronchitis Stomach aches/diarrhea Sore throat Pinkeye Poison ivy/rash 	24 hours a day, seven days a week	\$5 Copayment
Urgent care	Nonhospital facility that provides immediate care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sprains, strains Minor burns Small cuts that may need stitches 	Typically open seven days a week, no appointment required	\$30 Copayment
Emergency room	Hospital facility for life-threatening conditions that require immediate care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heavy bleeding Chest pain Burns Difficulty breathing Broken bones Any life-threatening condition 	24 hours a day, seven days a week	\$200 Copayment <i>(copayment waived if admitted)</i>
